

WI DHS safety suggestion for customers: 1. Stay home if you are sick. 2. Cover any coughs and sneezes with your elbow. 3. Wear a cloth face covering. 4. Do not bring children with you to the market if you have child care available. 5. Minimize the number of people coming with you to the market; this helps keep crowds smaller. 6. Use hand sanitizer or hand-washing stations frequently, if available. 7. Maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance from other customers and vendors whenever possible. 8. Come to the market at off-peak hours.
