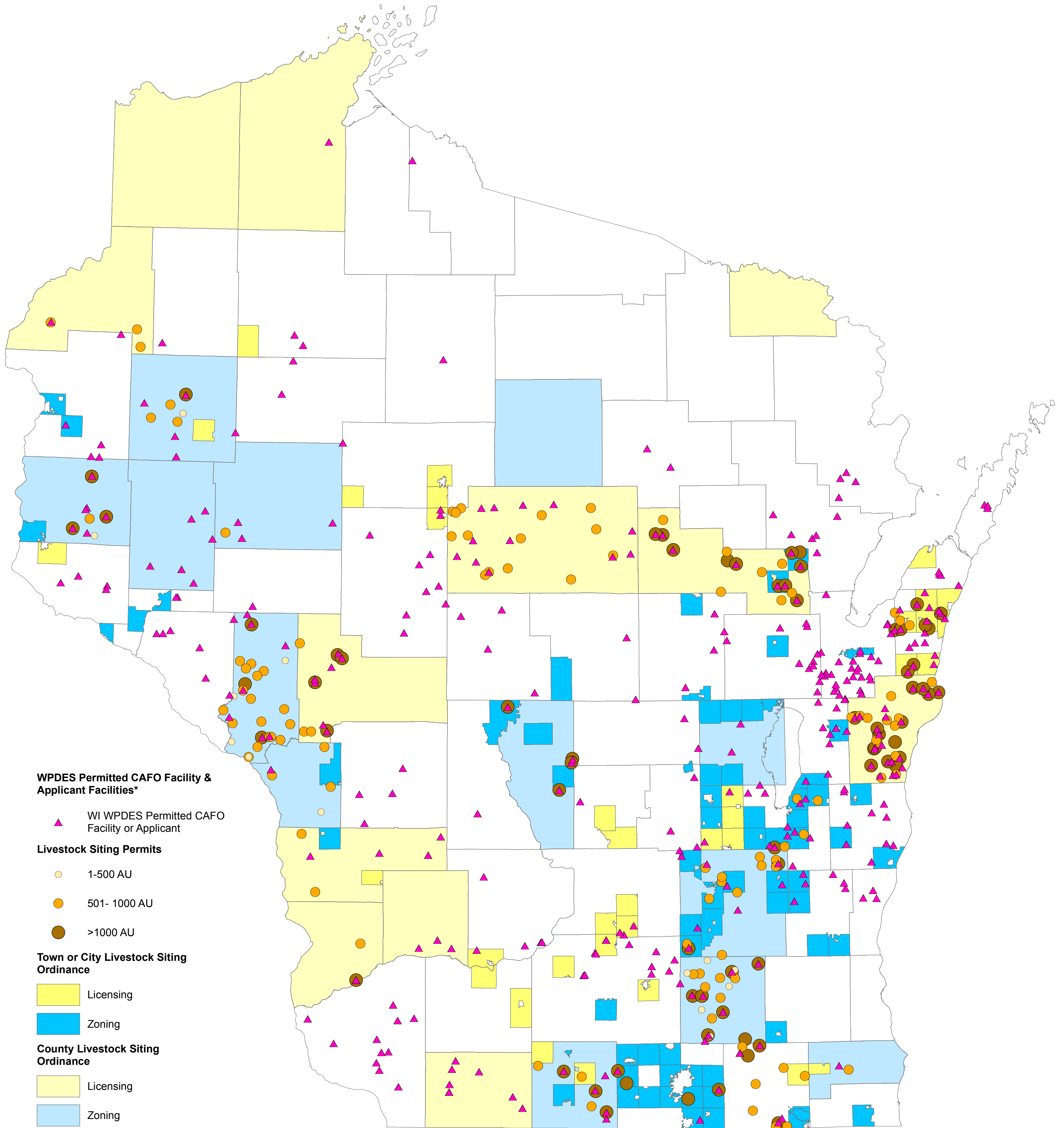


Wisconsin Livestock Facility Siting Program and Wisconsin WPDES Permitted Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations and Permit Applicants



In 2019, Walworth County amended its zoning ordinance to withdraw the requirement for issuance of a conditional use permit (CUP) for new or expanding livestock facilities over 500 animal units.
 *This layer includes WPDES permitted CAFO facilities and permit applicants.

This map shows the approximate boundaries and status of 1) permitting authorities that have adopted livestock facility siting 2) generalized locations of approved livestock facility siting permits and 3) WPDES permitted Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations and applicants in Wisconsin. It is intended for general reference, rather than site-specific uses. CAFO permit data was obtained from the Department Natural Resources (DNR) and was last updated in October of 2019. Livestock facility siting permitting authority and permit data was compiled by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) and is updated for November of 2019. This dataset is not an authoritative source of information about legal land ownership, parcel boundaries, or public access.
