***Online exams.** Participants will have 1 week to complete exams. **Fee payment** at the time of online registration. Individuals must have access to a computer and reliable internet.

Cost: \$200.00/person, plus \$100/person for **additional persons** registering from the same business at the same time. Cost includes materials, certificate of completion, and research-based advice on getting products to market. **You must pre-register.**

About this training: This training is for food businesses who intend to process and package acid or acidified foods under license - food products such as jams and jellies, salsas and pickles, and sauces or spreads. This course also meets the training requirement for licensing for businesses manufacturing **acidified foods** (pickles and salsa) under **FDA 21 CFR 114**. This course also meets **FDA requirements under the Food Safety Modernization Act** (21 CFR 117.4). A score of 70% on exams is required for successful completion of this course. Participants can expect to dedicate 12 – 16 hours to this training.

Training requires a minimum of 6 participants; maximum of 20. If a training is canceled due to low enrollment, registrants may move to the next available session or will be offered a full refund.
