4-H is the nation's largest positive youth development and youth mentoring organization, empowering over six million people every day!

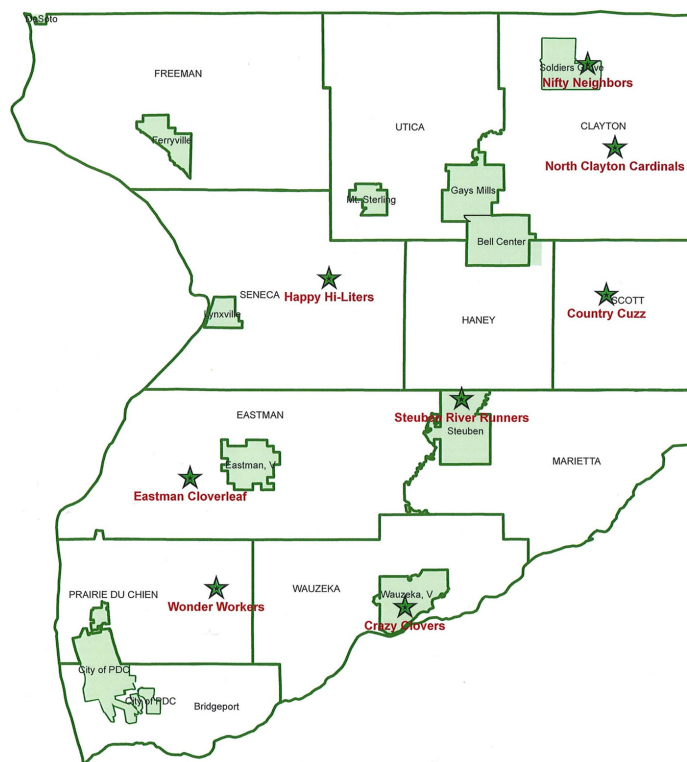
