Questions to ask

What questions should I ask when interviewing someone to care for my child?



- What is your discipline and behavior management policy?
- What is your daily routine and curriculum?
- Can you describe a typical day for a child in your care?
- Do you have a structured curriculum or educational activities for the children?
- What safety measures do you have in place?
- How do you ensure the safety of the children in your care?
- Are there emergency procedures in place, such as first-aid training and fire drills?
- Are you licensed by the state or accredited by any relevant organizations?
- What is your experience and background in childcare?
- How long have you been providing childcare services?
- What is your child-to-caregiver ratio?
- How do you ensure each child receives individualized attention?
- What are your operating hours and fees?
- What are your hours of operation? Do you offer flexible hours?
- What is the cost of your services, and are there any additional fees or charges?
